The following issues were discussed and the following steps taken:-

APPRISAL: 1

The Principal was informed that 3 notice boards should be provided by the college to display results, notices, advertisements and academic activities of the students.

APPRISAL: 3

The NAAC Pre-Peer Team visited the college on 26th and 27th March 2017 and did Academic and Administrative Audit. The results given by the team was distributed in the meeting among the members and their suggestions were taken up.

The Peer team has made few observations on which discussions took place

These are the strength of the institution

- Ideally suited college location, adequate campus infrastructure.
- Young and enthusiastic management and faculty
- Exhibition of good team work at various levels including participatory and co operative management.
- Locational advantage of the college may be utilized for the demographic inclusion

Further the Pre Peer team has observed some weaknesses regarding the institution. That is-

- 1. Shortage of teaching faculty
- 2. Infrastructure needs to be improved
- 3. Ramps needed for differently able persons be constructed

Opportunities observed by the Pre-Peer team

- 1. Introduction of more value added and job oriented courses
- 2. Introduction of teacher education programme (B.Ed)

- 2. Recruit and retain qualified and experienced faculty.

ACTION TAKEN:-

As suggested by the Pre-Peer team of Academic and Administrative Audit, some steps have been taken by the college authority:-

- 1. Steps have been taken to appoint a sports teacher
- 2. A ramp has been constructed again for differently able students.
- 3. The digitalization of the library will be done in the new building
- 4. The internet speed of the college has been upgraded to 300 mbps per day.

Further the following decisions have been taken-

- 1. International Women's Day was celebrated on 08.03.17 by Women Cell and Economic Department. On this day two guest speakers were invited to give a talk on 'Women Empowerment: Past, Present and future'. The two eminent speakers were Ms. Mamoni Devi Associate Prof. Assamese Dept. Naharkatia College and Dr. Prabhat Sharma Ex. Principal, Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya.
- 2. A Career Counselling Programme on Aviation and Hospitality Industry was held on 17.03.17 by Pragati School of Management from R-G- Baruah Road, Guwahati.
- 3. Namami Brahmaputra, the largest river festival of India, an international festival that celebrates the beauty of the Brahmaputra River was organized by the Govt. of Assam on 1st and 2nd of April 2017. On this occasion students participated on a cultural procession led by the students from the college. Students of the Dept. of Economics had an interaction with small scale industries entrepreneurs and large scale industries entrepreneurs who came from all over India and were present on the occasion.
- 4. The Earth Day will be celebrated on 22nd of April 2017 with a view to protect the planet from pollution and deforestation. On this occasion, there will be plantation of trees in the hostel premises.
