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Introduction:

The NSS Unit of Duliajan Girls' College was introduced in the year 2015. The unit is playing an active role since its inception. The NSS Unit of Duliajan Girls' College has done different activities in relation to personality development of students through community services. Mr. Amrit Chandra Kalita, Assistant Professor, Department of Hindi, is the Programme Officer of NSS Unit of the College. At present, the NSS Unit of Duliajan Girls' College has one Programme Officer with 100 student volunteers. NSS is under the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Govt. of India.
