

Brief description/Summary of events : The Moran Blind School is located in Moran. The school was founded by Major S.N. Banerjee in the year 1971. He was inspired to do something worthwhile for the most neglected section of the society. The school raising awareness in the community in regards to caring for disable children. We interacted with the staff and tutors of the school. The school has currently, about 80 pupils with visual impairment. They provide teaching and learning materials. They carry out home visits and attend PTA meeting to sensitize the family on the importance of education. Residential facilities are also offered. Boys and girls live in segregated dormitories. The school has a temple, weaving centre (vocational), kitchen, auditorium, dinning hall, toilets. At Moran Blind School these children got a new lease of life at total rehab, an environment in which they receive proper care.

Conclusion/outcome : Rehabilitation services can help persons with disability to live independently and participate in education, labour market and social activities.







These children got a new lease of life at total rehab, an environment in which they receive proper care.
